## ADVENTIST SCREENING VERIFICATION Child Protection Training Background Screening

Several years ago the Greater New York Conference, as recommended by the North American Division, partnered with *Shield the Vulnerable* for Child Protection Training and Background Screening. Later we changed to *Verified Volunteers*. More recently they changed their name to *Sterling Volunteers*. While *Sterling Volunteers* is still the organization that provides the service, the permanent name chosen by the North American Division for us is *ADVENTIST SCREENING VERIFICATION*.

This new web-based platform features a training and screening system for both employees and volunteers across all Conferences in the Division.

Remember that all those who work with our children and youth (Sabbath School, Pathfinders, Adventurers, AY, Food Pantry, Schools, etc.) need to go thru this training and background check.

Also remember that the background check must be renewed every three years.

To get started, please follow the steps outlined below:

First time registrants will be asked to choose a state. Regardless of where you live please choose New York since that is where our churches are. Then you will choose Conference –Greater New York. Then you will be asked to create your account.
